Minister Brenda F. Troy is the wife of Dr. Keith A. Troy, Pastor of the New Salem Baptist Church located in Columbus, OH. Minister Troy was educated at both Kent State University and The Ohio State University, respectively where she was a Banking and Finance Major. Minister Troy is a graduate of the American Baptist Church Lay Pastor’s Training program. She holds a Bachelor of Arts in Pastoral Leadership from Newburgh Theological Seminary. Minister Troy was licensed in the Gospel ministry in 2005 at the New Salem Baptist Church. In addition, she is a versed business owner and has extensive experience in the Banking and Human Resources industries. God has blessed her with many opportunities to deliver training to more than 10,000 people in the areas of spiritual growth, personal and professional development, business administration, and organizational management. She also established a family owned foundation MTASK, to leave a legacy to her children.

Minster Troy serves as the director of New Salem’s Promiseland Children Ministry, the Hospitality Department, and the Woman of Power (WOP) Ministry where she has served for over 20 years. Through her passion to serve women she founded the Woman of Power Retreat and Conference, in 2012 established the Sankofa House, a safe haven for women coming out of prison reentering society, and also established the WOP Clothing Boutique where they provide free clothing for women, men, and children. In addition, she further helped establish a community collaborative with over twelve agencies to deliver programs to community residents. This outreach has allowed her to counsel more than 2,500 women.

Minister Troy is very active in the community and has served with various organizations including Action for Children, Franklin County Children Services, Lott Carey Board of Foreign Missions for Women, and the Lott Carey Teenage Sex Trafficking International Committee. She has served diligently with CHOICES Domestic Violence, a shelter for abused women.

Minister Troy has received numerous awards for her outstanding dedication to serving women, youth, and children with her most recent awards being The President’s Lifetime Achievement Award from President Barack Obama for her service in Anti-Human Trafficking, The Cooperate Connections Donna A. James Award in 2018, and recognized by Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. Gamma Zeta Zeta Chapter for her humanitarian work in 2020.

She has preached in Italy, Botswana, South Africa, and Germany ministering to women involved in Human Trafficking all over the country and the Columbus, OH vicinity, as part of her calling to women and children. She continues to spearhead annual workshops both in the states and internationally to provide information on social ills that serves as impediments to realizing spiritual goals and espousing Christian values.
